



The Phoenix Federation School Accessibility Policy and Plan 2025

At The Phoenix Federation we are aware of our duty under the Equality Act 2010 to:

- Eliminate discrimination, harassment, victimization and any other conduct that is prohibited by or under this Act
- Advance equality of opportunity between persons who share a relevant protected characteristic and persons who do not share it.
- Foster good relations between persons who share a protected characteristic and persons who do not share it.

The purpose of the accessibility plan is to fulfil all of the above. Phoenix Federation is committed to providing a fully accessible environment which values and includes all pupils, staff, parents and visitors regardless of their age, education, physical, sensory, social, spiritual, emotional and cultural needs. We also challenge negative attitudes about disability and accessibility and promote a culture of awareness, tolerance and inclusion.

- The Accessibility Plan will contain relevant actions to: Improved awareness of Equality and Inclusion.
- Improve access to the physical environment of the school, adding specialist facilities as necessary.
- Increased access to the teaching and learning and the wider curriculum of the school such as participation in after-school clubs, leisure and cultural activities or school visits.
- The provision of specialist aids and equipment, which may assist pupils in accessing the curriculum.
- Improve the delivery of written information to pupils, staff, parents and visitors with disabilities. Examples might include handouts, timetables, textbooks and information about the school and school events. The information should also be made available in various preferred formats within a reasonable time frame.
